Scarborough, Whitby & Ryedale Home from Hospital Service, the first 6 months

Going home after a spell in hospital can be a daunting prospect for many patients.

The Home From Hospital (HFH) service contacts clients within **24hours** of discharge to help ensure people are confident and comfortable when returning home.

Since April our HFH team have supported over 130 clients across our area.

Since April the service across North Yorkshire has helped **reduce re-admissions to hospital** by providing support to re-build confidence and independence for clients, as well as helping resolve any issues that may arise.

'the welcome pack was a lovely gesture & really useful for the first few days back at home'.

The **free** service includes a home visit to discuss any concerns and immediate needs the person may have as well as:

- a welcome home hamper
- weekly visits and calls for up to 6 weeks
- Helping with shopping & collecting prescriptions
- liaising with health and social care professionals
- help signpost to appropriate benefits
- help to organise ongoing support e.g. domiciliary services and befriending
